

## My Ham Radio Setup When Camping

When I go camping in my popup and I take my gear. It consists of two aluminum suitcases of equipment.



One is the antenna, and the other is the ICOM 7100, AT180 tuner and Astron SS30 power supply with a Bencher paddle, notepad and pens and small screwdriver to take cover off paddles.



I use a home made G5RV antenna with a Hastings 30 ft fiberglass telescopic pole that my son found in the curb after a storm.

I tie the pole to a tree and affix a pulley for a halyard to the top then raise it up. Then, using the halyard, I raise the center of the G5RV to the top of the pole. I run the ends out and using some line I got At Home Depot (pink and green) I raise the ends up to nearby trees.
